The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 15 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 14-69.3. Arson or other unlawful burning that results in serious injury to a firefighter. A person is guilty of a Class C felony if the person commits an offense under Article 15 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes and a firefighter suffers serious bodily injury while discharging or attempting to discharge the firefighter's duties as a result of the criminal offense." **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2003, and applies to
