A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  AN ACT TO REVISE THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE SECONTROLLER TO CLARIFY THAT THE CONTROLLER MAY CONCOMPLIANCE REVIEWS OF STATE AGENCIES AND TO EXEMPWORKING PAPERS FROM THOSE REVIEWS FROM THE PUBLIC RECLAWS.  The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  SECTION 1. G.S. 143B-426.39(1) reads as rewritten:  "§ 143B-426.39. Powers and duties of the State Controller.  The State Controller shall:  (1) Prescribe, develop, operate, and maintain in accordance with generate accounting system for all state agencies. The system shall be detent to assure compliance with all legal and constitutional requirements including those associated with the receipt and expenditure of, accountability for public funds. The State Controller may be review a State agency's compliance with prescribed uniform accounting system standards, as well as applicable legations constitutional requirements."  SECTION 2. Part 8 of Article 9 of Chapter 143B of the General State amended by adding a new section to read:	enerally m state esigned rements and the elect to m State al and
"§ 143B-426.39B. Compliance review work papers not public records.	

Work papers and other supportive material created as a result of a compliance review conducted under G.S. 143B-426.39(1) are not public records under Chapter 132 of the General Statutes. The State Controller may, unless otherwise prohibited by law, make work papers available for inspection by duly authorized representatives of the State and federal governments in connection with matters officially before them. Any report resulting from a compliance review is a public record under Chapter 132 of the General Statutes."
