The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Part 5 of Article 1 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "<u>§ 1</u>16-43.7. Social security number shall not be assigned as a student identification number. No constituent institution shall assign an individual identification number to a (a) student that is identical to or incorporates the student's social security number. No constituent institution shall allow the public display or use of a student's social security number or more than four consecutive numbers contained in the student's
