7		FION 1. G.S. 105-164.3 is amended by adding a new subdivision to

9	" <u>(9a)</u>	Farmer. – A dairy operator, poultry farmer, egg producer, Christmas
10		tree farmer, livestock farmer, crop farmer, tree farmer, nursery
11		operator, greenhouse operator, orchardist, a farmer of an aquatic
12		species as defined in G.S. 106-758, and any other person coming
13		within the generally accepted definition of the word. Farmer does not
14		include a person who merely cultivates a garden for personal use."
15	SECT	FION 2. G.S. 105-164.13(1) and (1a), as amended by Section 33.9 of
16	,	read as rewritten:
17	"(1)	Any of the following items sold to a farmer or to a lessor of farmland
18		who is responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of farmland for use
19		by the farmer or by a lessor of farmland or the lessor's lessee in the
20		planting, cultivating, harvesting, or curing of Christmas trees and farm
21		crops or in the production of dairy products, eggs, or animals. A
22		'farmer' includes a dairy operator, a poultry farmer, an egg producer, a
23		livestock farmer, a farmer of crops, and a farmer of an aquatic species,
24		as defined in G.S. 106-758.
25		a. Commercial fertilizer, lime, land plaster, plastic mulch, plant
26		bed covers, potting soil, and seeds.
27		b. Farm machinery, attachment and repair parts for farm
28		machinery, and lubricants applied to farm machinery. The term

1	'machinery' includes implements that have moving parts or are
2	operated or drawn by an animal. The term does not include
3	implements operated wholly by hand or motor vehicles required
4	to be registered under Chapter 20 of the General Statutes.
5	c. A horse or mule.
6	d. Fuel other than electricity.
7	(1a) A container sold to a farmer, as defined in subdivision (1) of this
8	section, section or to a lessor of farmland who is responsible for the
9	upkeep and maintenance of farmland used for a purpose set out in that
10	subdivision or in packaging and transporting the farmer's or lessor's
11	product for sale."
12	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective January 1, 2006, and applies to
13	sales made on or after that date.
