A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE TOWN OF NORTH WILKESBORO MAY ACQUIRE AND CONVEY PROPERTY TO THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA FOR USE AS A PRISON.  The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 600 of the 1995 Session Laws, a amended by S.L. 2000-31, S.L. 2002-85, and S.L. 2004-28, is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
"Section 1.(a) The Counties of Alexander, Anson, Bertie, Columbus, Greene Scotland, Stanly, and Transylvania have power under general law to acquire real an personal property and convey it to the State under G.S. 160A-274 or other applicable law for use as correctional facilities.
<b>Section 1.(b)</b> The Town of Windsor has the power under the general law to acquir real and personal property and convey it to the State under G.S. 160A-274 or other applicable law for use as a correctional facility. It may acquire that property by eminer domain, and such power under this subsection is supplementary to any other power may have to take property by eminent domain.
Section 1.(c) The Town of North Wilkesboro has the power under general law tacquire real and personal property and convey it to the State under G.S. 160A-274 of
other applicable law for use as a correctional facility."
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
