SESSION LAW 2005-280 SENATE BILL 669

AN ACT TO REPEAL LEGISLATION THAT MADE STATE LAND SUBJECT TO MUNICIPAL PLANNING JURISDICTION AND PERMITTED THE IMPOSITION OF OVERLAY AND SPECIAL USE DISTRICTS ON STATE LAND WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE COUNCIL OF STATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 41(e) of S.L. 2004-199 is repealed. **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law. In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 9th day of August, 2005.
