A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT 3 ASHEVILLE MAY RETAIN THE PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF REAL 4 PROPERTY AND USE THE PROCEEDS TO CONSTRUCT OR ACQUIRE A 5 NEW CHANCELLOR'S RESIDENCE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the University of 7 North Carolina at Asheville may retain the proceeds from the sale of its existing 8 chancellor's residence and appurtenant land. The University of North Carolina at 9 10 Asheville may use the proceeds from the sale of its existing chancellor's residence and 11 the appurtenant land and any other nonappropriated funds available to construct or

12 otherwise acquire a new chancellor's residence. Proceeds from the sale not used for that

13 purpose within two fiscal years of the sale shall revert to the General Fund.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
