Short Title: North Carolina Libraries Special Plate. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE A
3 NORTH CAROLINA LIBRARIES SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten:

6 "(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration
7 plates:

8 ...

9 (28f) North Carolina Libraries. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor
10 vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the
11 words "North Carolina Libraries" and bear the international logo for
12 libraries. The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
13 plate before it may be developed."

14 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

15 "(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one
16 registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 100% disabled
17 veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates, including
18 additional Congressional Medal of Honor, 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of
19 War plates, are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or
20 G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:

42 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 20-79.7(b) reads as rewritten:

43 "(b) Distribution of Fees. – The Special Registration Plate Account and the
44 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway

1 Fund. The Division must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration
 2 plates listed in subsection (a) among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the
 3 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), the Natural Heritage Trust
 4 Fund (NHTF), which is established under G.S. 113-77.7, and the Parks and Recreation
 5 Trust Fund, which is established under G.S. 113-44.15, as follows:

13 **SECTION 4.** G.S. 20-81.12 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
14 "(b39) North Carolina Libraries. – The Division must receive 300 or more
15 applications for the North Carolina Libraries plate before the plate may be developed.
16 The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction
17 Plate Account derived from the sale of the North Carolina Libraries plates to the North
18 Carolina Library Association, Inc., for the Association's public programs."

19 **SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
