A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE HOUSE SELECT COMMITTEE ON THE EDUCATION OF STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES TO ALLOW STUDENTS PLACED ON SHORT-TERM SUSPENSIONS TO TAKE THEIR TEXTBOOKS HOME FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHORT-TERM SUSPENSION AND TO HAVE ACCESS TO HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-391(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) The principal of a school, or his delegate, shall have authority to suspend for a period of 10 days or less any student who willfully violates policies of conduct established by the local board of ~~education~~. ~~Provided, that a~~ education. A student suspended ~~pursuant to~~ under this subsection shall be provided ~~an opportunity to take any quarterly, semester or grading period examinations missed during the suspension period~~. all of the following:

- (1) The opportunity to take textbooks home for the duration of the suspension.
- (2) The right to inquire about homework assignments for the duration of the suspension.
- (3) The opportunity to take any quarterly, semester, or grading period examinations missed during the suspension period."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
