SECTION 1. G.S. 50B-4.1(f) reads as rewritten:

LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

"(f) Unless covered under some other provision of law providing greater punishment, any person who knowingly violates a valid protective order as provided in subsection (a) of this section, after having been previously convicted of three offenses one offense under this Chapter, shall be guilty of a Class H felony."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
