The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 50B-4.1(f) reads as rewritten:
"(f) Unless covered under some other provision of law providing greate
punishment, any person who knowingly violates a valid protective order as provided in
subsection (a) of this section, after having been previously convicted of three two
offenses under this Chapter, shall be guilty of a Class H felony."
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective December 1, 2008, and applies to
offenses committed on or after that date.
