4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-321(a) is amended by adding three new subsections
6	to read:
7	"(a1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Chapter, information contained in
8	a personnel file that is relevant to possible criminal misconduct may be made available
9	to law enforcement and the district attorney to assist in the investigation of:
10	(1) <u>A report made to law enforcement pursuant to G.S. 115C-288(g), or</u>
11	(2) Any report to law enforcement regarding an arson, attempted arson,
12	destruction of, theft from, theft of, embezzlement from, embezzlement
13	of any personal or real property owned by the local board of education.
14	(a2) The employee shall be given five working days prior written notice of any
15	disclosure under subsection (a1) of this section to permit the employee to apply to the
16	district court for an in camera review prior to the date of disclosure to determine if the
17	information is relevant to the possible criminal misconduct. Failure of the employee to
18	apply for a review shall constitute a waiver by the employee of any relief under this
19	subsection.
20	(a3) Statements or admissions made by the employee under the expressed threat of
21	termination for failure to respond to questions by the local board of education shall not
22	be admissible in any subsequent criminal proceeding against the employee."
23	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
