The Commissioner issues a Bulletin Advisory notifying all insurance 1 (1) 2 carriers licensed in this State of a declared state of disaster or state of 3 emergency in North Carolina. The Department shall provide a copy of 4 the Bulletin to the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy. 5 The covered person requesting coverage of the refill or replacement <u>(2)</u> 6 prescription resides in a county that: 7 Is covered under a proclamation of state of disaster issued by <u>a.</u> 8 the Governor or by a resolution of the General Assembly under 9 G.S. 166A-6, or a declaration of major disaster issued by the 10 President of the United States under the Robert T. Stafford 11 Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. § 12 5121, et seg., as amended; or 13 Is declared to be under a state of emergency in a proclamation b. 14 issued by the Governor under G.S. 14-288.15. 15 <u>(3)</u> The prescription medication is requested within 29 days after the origination date of the conditions stated in subdivision (b)(1) of this 16 17 section. 18 The time period for the waiver of prescription medication refills may be (c) 19 extended in 30-day increments by an order issued by the Commissioner. Additional 20 refills still remaining on a prescription shall be covered by the insurer as long as 21 consistent with the orders of the prescriber or authority of the dispensing pharmacy. 22 This section does not excuse or exempt an insured or subscriber from any 23 other terms of the policy or certificate providing coverage for prescription medications. 24 Quantity limitations shall be consistent with the original prescription and the 25 extra or replacement fill may recognize proportionate dosage use prior to the disaster. 26 No requirements additional to those under the pharmacy provider agreement or the prescription benefit plan may be placed upon the provider for coverage of the 27 28 replacement fill or extra fill. 29 Nothing in this section is intended to affect the respective authority or scope
