The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 4 5 **SECTION 1.** Article 1 of Chapter 90 of the General Statutes is amended by 6 adding the following new section to read: 7 "§ 90-2.2. Surgery defined. For purposes of this Article, the term "surgery" means the diagnosis or therapeutic 8 treatment of conditions or disease processes by any instrument causing localized 9 alteration or transposition of live human tissue or organs including but not limited to 10 lasers, ultrasound, ionizing radiation, scalpels, probes, and needles in which human 11 tissue or organs are cut, burned, vaporized, frozen, sutured, probed, manipulated by 12

closed reduction for major dislocations and fractures, or otherwise altered by any

mechanical thermal, light-based, electromagnetic, or chemical means."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
