**PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENT(S) & PROGRAM(S) AFFECTED:** North Carolina General Assembly, Department of the State Treasurer

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** Effective when it becomes law.

**BILL SUMMARY**: This bill requires the Retirement System Division of the Department of the State Treasurer to provide the Fiscal Research Division direct read-only access to retirement databases. The bill is identical to S.B. 940, filed on 3/19/07.

**ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:** This bill codifies the legislative intent that fiscal analysts in the General Assembly's Fiscal Research Division have access to the State's retirement databases. A negligible fiscal impact to the State Treasurer's Retirement System Division includes the re-establishment of accounts, usernames, and network maintenance. These tasks do not require the creation of new positions, as both of these can be accomplished with existing resources. Therefore, no substantive fiscal impact is associated with this legislation.
