A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 2 AN ACT DIRECTING THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO DEVELOP OR 3 IDENTIFY ACADEMICALLY RIGOROUS HONORS-LEVEL COURSES IN HEALTH 4 AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION THAT CAN BE OFFERED AT THE HIGH SCHOOL 5 LEVEL. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 7 SECTION 1. Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new 8 section to read: 9 "§ 115C-81.4. Honors-level courses in health and physical education. The State Board of Education shall develop or identify academically rigorous honors-level 10 courses in health and physical education that can be offered at the high school level. These 11 honors-level courses shall be more challenging than standard-level courses, provide multiple 12 opportunities for students to take greater responsibility for their learning, and require higher 13 quality work from the students than standard courses." 14
- 15 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
