 AN ACT AUTHORIZING COUNTIES AND MUNICIPALITIES TO PROVIDE
 DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVES IN EXCHANGE FOR REDUCTIONS IN ENERGY
 CONSUMPTION.
 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 160A-383.4 reads as rewritten:

"§ 160A-383.4. Local energy efficiency incentives.

8 Land-Use Development Incentives. - Counties and municipalities, for the purpose (a) of reducing the amount of energy consumption by new development, and thereby promoting 9 10 the public health, safety, and welfare, may adopt ordinances to grant a density bonus, make 11 adjustments to otherwise applicable development requirements, or provide other incentives to a developer or builder within the county or municipality and its extraterritorial planning 12 jurisdiction if the developer or builder agrees to construct new development or reconstruct 13 14 existing development in a manner that the county or municipality determines, based on 15 generally recognized standards established for such purposes, makes a significant contribution to the reduction of energy consumption. 16

(b) [Applicability.] This section applies only to Cabarrus County, the Cities of
 Asheville, Charlotte, Concord, Durham, Kannapolis, Locust, and Wilmington, and to the
 Towns of Carrboro, Cary, Chapel Hill, Harrisburg, Midland, Mount Pleasant, and Stanfield."

20 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
