Whereas, one in nine North Carolinians is at risk for developing chron	nic kidney
disease (CKD); and	
Whereas, an increasing number of North Carolinians are at risk for develo	1 0
due to our aging population, our level of obesity, plus the complications of dia	ibetes and
hypertension; and	
Whereas, almost half of those who currently have CKD may have be	en able to
prevent contracting this disease had they known the risk factors; and	
Whereas, early detection and treatment of CKD may prevent undue suf	
need for dialysis treatments, and kidney transplantation, and decrease the financial	burden of
CKD on the State; and	
Whereas, the month of March is recognized as National Kidney Month; an	
Whereas, observing the month of March as Kidney Month in the State	of North
Carolina would help to promote public awareness of CKD; Now, therefore,
