4 5	ACT SHALL BE ENTITLED "DUFFY'S LAW." Whereas, according to the United Network of Organ Sharing (UNOS), more than
6	116,000 people are waiting for organ transplants nationally, and more than 3,500 of those
7	people are in North Carolina; and
8	Whereas, an average of 18 people awaiting transplants die each day due to the
9	severe shortage of donated organs; and
10	Whereas, every 10 minutes another name is added to the national transplant waiting
11 12	list; and Whereas, one organ denor can save the lives of up to eight people and improve the
12	Whereas, one organ donor can save the lives of up to eight people and improve the lives of up to 50 people through tissue and cornea donation; and
13 14	Whereas, North Carolinians are encouraged to get the facts about donation through
15	Donate Life NC's Web site and discuss their wishes with their families; and
16	Whereas, the North Carolina Division of Motor Vehicles plays a critical role in
17	maintaining the North Carolina State donor registry, with 99% of donors having registered
18	when receiving their North Carolina drivers license or ID card, which are identified by the
19	symbol of a red heart; and
20	Whereas, the State's Donor registry is the sixth largest registry in the country with
21	4.3 million North Carolinians having registered with the North Carolina Division of Motor
22	Vehicles or through Donate Life NC's online registry; and
23	Whereas, the State of North Carolina joins Donate Life NC, our State's organ
24 25	recovery agencies, Carolina Donor Services, The North Carolina Eye Bank, LifeShare Of The
23 26	Carolinas, health care professionals, volunteers, educators, government agencies, faith-based and community groups, and private organizations in an effort to boost the numbers of organ,
20 27	tissue, eye, blood, bone marrow, and stem cell donors throughout North Carolina; Now,
28	therefore,
29	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
30	SECTION 1. Chapter 103 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
31	section to read:
32	" <u>§ 103-12. Organ Donation Awareness/Donate Life Month.</u>
33	The month of April of each year is designated as Organ Donation Awareness/Donate Life
34	Month in North Carolina."
35	SECTION 2. This act shall be known as "Duffy's Law."
36	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
