

 SECTION 3. G.S. 20-79.7(b) reads as rewritten:

30 "(b) Distribution of Fees. – The Special Registration Plate Account and the Collegiate 31 and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway Fund. The Division 32 must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration plates listed in subsection (a) 33 of this section among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the Collegiate and 34 Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), the Natural Heritage Trust Fund (NHTF), which 35 is established under G.S. 113-77.7, and the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund, which is 36 established under G.S. 113-44.15, as follows:
