March 16, 2015 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AMENDING THE PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS ACT TO MODIFY EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE PRACTICE OF COUNSELING. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 90-336(b) reads as rewritten: "(b)The Board shall issue a license as a "licensed professional counselor associate" to an applicant who meets all of the following criteria: Has earned a minimum of 48 semester hours or 72 quarter credit hours of graduate training as defined by the Board, including a master's degree in counseling or a related field from a regionally or nationally accredited institution of higher education if the applicant enrolled in the master's program before July 1, 2009; a minimum of 54 semester hours or 81 quarter credit hours of graduate training as defined by the Board, including a master's degree in counseling or a related field from a regionally or nationally accredited institution of higher education if the applicant enrolled in the master's program before July 1, 2013, but after June 30, 2009; or a minimum of 60 semester hours or 90 quarter credit hours of graduate training as defined by the Board, including a master's degree in counseling or a related field from a regionally or nationally accredited institution of higher education if the applicant enrolled in the master's program after June 30, 2013.
