The General	Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
S	ECTION 1. Section 2 of S.L. 2015-174 reads as rewritten:	
"SECTION	ON 2.(a) The governing body of a municipality may donate any	horse, dog, or other
animal used	by the municipality's police department or any other municipal a	gency to the officer
or employee	who had normal custody and control of the animal during	its service to the
municipality	when the animal is deemed no longer fit for public service.	
"SECTION	ON 2.(b) This section applies only to the Towns of Apex, Cary,	Garner, Knightdale,
Wake Forest	and Zebulon and to the municipalities in Mecklenburg County."	

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
