The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, the Department of Transportation shall not require environmental documentation under the North Carolina Environmental Policy Act from any airport meeting all of the following requirements: The airport is acquiring 40 acres or less of property for future airport (1) development. The airport is located in a county with a population of greater than 900,000 (2) people, according to the most recent decennial federal census. The airport has a total annual enplanement of over 20,000,000 passengers, (3) according to the most recent data provided by the Federal Aviation Administration.
