9	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:					
10	SECTION 1. Article 15 of Chapter 143B of the General Statutes is amended by					
11	adding a new section to read:					
12	2 " <u>§ 143B-1417. Text or short message service emergency communications.</u>					
13	A PSAP with the capability to receive text or short message service (SMS) messages shall					
14	utilize text or SMS messages as an option for a person to contact an appropriate PSAP for					
15	emergency assistance."					
16	SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund sixty-five thousand					
17	dollars (\$65,000.00) recurring to the Department of Information Technology for the purpose of					
18	creating one new full-time equivalent (FTE) position within the Department to coordinate and					
19	assist public safety answering points statewide in implementing best practices and community					
20	education related to 911 emergency communications via text and short message service (SMS).					
21	SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act becomes effective October 1, 2018. The remainder					
22	of this act becomes effective July 1, 2018.
