8	amendments set out in Sections 1 and 2 of this act, the State Board of Elections shall certify the	
9	amendments to the Secretary of State, and the amendments become effective upon certification.	
10	The Secretary of State shall enroll the amendments so certified among the permanent records of	
11	that office.	
12	<b>SECTION 5.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
