1	(2) Allocations shall be competitive and, after consultation with the Department		
2	of Commerce, awarded to proposals with the greatest projected economic		
3	impact benefitting North Carolina.		
4	(h) Administrative Costs. – The Department may use no more than three percent (3%) of		
5	the Fund for administrative costs.		
6	(i) <u>Report. – No later than March 1, 2025, the Division shall submit an initial report on</u>		
7	the implementation of this section to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental		
8	Operations, the Joint Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee, and the Fiscal Research		
9	Division and thereafter shall submit an annual report no later than December 1 of each year. The		
10	report shall include the following information: use of funds, projects approved, and estimated		
11	economic impact."		
12	<b>SECTION 2.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Special Economic		
13	Development Fund for Airports the sum of two hundred million dollars (\$200,000,000) in		
14	nonrecurring funds.		
15	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
